

EUCLID STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT

Background

- On April 2, 2019, Council approved the use of RMRA/SB1 funds for the pavement rehabilitation of Euclid Street from Williamson Ave to Fern Drive.
- Project is listed in the FY 2019-20 Capital Improvement Budget as part of the Arterial Street Reconstruction, Rehabilitation and Repair Project.
- Euclid Street – Fern Drive to Bastanchury Road is planned for rehabilitation in FY 2020-21. This project will also utilize SB1 funds.

Project Scope

- Project Details:
 - **Euclid Street - Williamson Avenue to Fern Drive**
 - Length is approximately 0.70 mile
- RMRA/SB 1 funds will be used to improve the pavement surface, repair curb, gutter and sidewalk, improve ADA curb ramps, construct new curb and gutter where currently missing, and new signing and striping.
- Sewer Enterprise Fund will be used to replace the sewer main in Euclid St and the siphon under Brea Creek Channel.
