The City of Fullerton Emergency Operations Plan is designed to ensure the most effective and economical allocation of resources for the maximum benefit and protection of the civilian population in times of emergency. This plan establishes emergency organization, assigns tasks and specifies policies and general procedures. The plan also provides coordination for planning the efforts of the various emergency staff and

service elements utilizing the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

This Emergency Operations Plan is an extension of the California Emergency Plan. It will be reviewed and exercised periodically and revised as necessary to meet changing conditions.
