RE: Consultant Traffic Engineering Services Contract Renewal from July 2018 to June 2020

Dear Mr. Hoppe:

Mr. Mark Miller, Executive Vice President of Albert Grover & Associates, has been serving as the City Traffic Engineer for Fullerton since 1997. At your request, we are agreeable to continue providing the various traffic engineering services required by the City.

Generally, AGA will serve as the City Traffic Engineer and will perform professional traffic engineering services necessary to render advice and assistance to the City Council, the City's Transportation and Circulation Commission (T&CC) and the City Engineering Department. Specifically, AGA will provide (at a minimum) the following services to the City:

- 1. Provide a minimum of eight (8) hours per week in the person of Mark Miller, P.E., who will serve as the City's Traffic Engineer. It is proposed that these eight hours will usually be provided on Tuesdays. Additional hours will be provided as needed throughout the week. Mr. Miller will also attend and serve as staff at the T&CC meetings once each month, and attend regular City Council meetings as requested by the Director.
- 2. Prepare traffic engineering staff reports for the T&CC and the City Council meetings and make presentations of these reports as requested by the Director.
- 3. Prepare and/or review plans for traffic signals, roadway signing and striping for routine City capital projects.
- 4. Review traffic and street alignment plans for private developments, and determine appropriate mitigation for development projects. It should be noted that AGA also maintains the City's Traffic Model.
- 5. Prepare or assist in responses to complaints and concerns from the public regarding traffic issues, in conjunction with Engineering staff.
- 6. Review the operations of the City's traffic signal system and recommend and/or implement changes with the approval of the Director.

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- 7. Prepare reports and minor studies for compliance with various County and State requirements, such as for Measure M and Congestion Management funding.
- 8. Provide training of City engineering staff in traffic engineering software.
- 9. Perform other functions that are considered routine to the City's Traffic Engineer position.
- 10. Comply with all Federal, State and local laws and ordinances, all to the reasonable satisfaction of the City.

While the majority of these services will be provided directly by Mr. Miller, AGA's entire staff will be available to provide traffic engineering assistance to the City. These services will be performed at the hourly rates as shown on the attached Schedule of Hourly Rates. These rates cover the cost of all staff time and all other direct and indirect costs or fees, including the work of AGA's employees and subconsultants. AGA's Hourly Rate Schedule is subject to change periodically; however, the rates charged to the City will remain fixed until such new rates are accepted/approved by the City. Existing rates have not been increased since July 2014; however, new positions and rates were added and updated in January 2018.

In recognition of the opportunity to provide engineering services on an extended term basis, the compensation for Mr. Miller's services as the City's Traffic Engineer shall be billed at the discounted rate of \$205 per hour for Fiscal Year 2018-2020. This is the same rate that was used for the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 and represents a discount of 18% when compared to Mr. Miller's normal billing rate at \$250 per hour.

The above scope of services can be extended indefinitely in annual increments upon City acceptance of the then current AGA rate schedule.
