SUBJECT: EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT

SUMMARY

The Fullerton Fire Department, as a sub-recipient, has received grant funding in the amount of \$18,084 under the Fiscal Year 2019 Emergency Management Grant (EMPG) from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services. The sub-recipient performance period for this grant is July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021. The grant funds will be appropriated in Fund 32 for Fiscal Year 2019-20.
