Both the City and Successor Agency maintain accounts with the State of California – LAIF, managed by the State Treasurer's Office. The City and Successor Agency need to update authorized staff managing LAIF accounts via resolution approved by the governing body of the agency. The reason for the update is staff and title changes. Ellis Chang was hired as Director of Administrative Services and appointed as City Treasurer and the former Fiscal Services Manager changed position to Revenue Manager.

The persons or positions authorized to process transactions (deposits, withdrawals and online account viewing access) are: City Treasurer, Director of Administrative Services, Revenue Manager and Utility Services Supervisor.
