FUNDING PROGRAM AGREEMENT AND AWARD

SUMMARY

Authorize acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$77,205 for the Fullerton Police Department expenditures due to COVID-19.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Authorize acceptance of grant award and authorize City Manager to execute \$77,205 Bureau of Justice Assistance FY20 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program Award Agreement.
2. Authorize appropriation of receipt and use of grant funds.

FISCAL IMPACT

The award of \$77,205 will help offset the department's costs incurred due to COVID-19.

DISCUSSION

The Department of Justice and Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded the Fullerton Police Department a Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program grant in the amount of \$77,205. All funds awarded under the CESF Program must be utilized to prevent, prepare for and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Fullerton Police Department has been approved to purchase supplies, equipment and personal protective equipment for use within the department for social distancing and sanitizing in

order to uphold and protect the health and safety of department employees, as well as residents who come in contact with the department. Additionally, the funds are approved to be used to support the overtime costs of sworn and non-sworn staff operations in response to COVID-19.
