

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, ASSIGNING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE AS AUTHORIZED SIGNER FOR AGREEMENTS WITH COUNTY OF ORANGE COMMUNITY SERVICES OFFICE ON AGING FOR FUNDING OF OLDER ADULT PROGRAMS

The County of Orange Community Services Office on Aging has the responsibility by the County of Orange Board of Supervisors for the administration of the funding allocations for Older Americans Act programs, setting up necessary procedures governing the application.

The County of Orange Community Services Office on Aging has recommended to the County of Orange Board of Supervisors to award the City with funding for older adult programs, to support enriching activities that promote health, vitality and well-being.

Procedures established by the County of Orange Community Services Office on Aging require the award recipients to certify by resolution an authorized signer for all matters pertaining to the Older Americans Act program.

City Council delegated signature authority to the Parks and Recreation Director or Designee in April of 2020, and considering organizational restructuring, the City must reassign signature authority to the City Manager or designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FOUND DETERMINED AND RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Council hereby grants and approves the signing authority for the Older Americans Act funding to the City Manager or designee.
2. Certifies that if the County of Orange Board of Supervisors said application, it represents and certifies that it will use all such funds in a manner consistent and in compliance with all applicable state and federal statutes, rules, regulations and laws, including without limitation all rules and laws regarding the Older Americans Act program; and
2. Delegates authority to the City Manager or designee to sign and submit all documents pertaining to agreements between the City of Fullerton and the County of Orange Community Services Office on Aging.
