

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, REAUTHORIZING THE FEE DEFERRAL PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 3281 FOR AN ADDITIONAL TWELVE MONTHS

RECITALS

WHEREAS the City adopted Ordinance No. 3281 in May 2020, establishing a Fee Deferral Program to temporarily defer collection of specified Development Impact Fees from building permit issuance until the issuance of Temporary Certificate of Occupancy or Final Certificate of Occupancy.

WHEREAS the City established the Fee Deferral Program for an initial term to accept applications by June 1, 2021 with all approvals by July 1, 2021.

WHEREAS City Council may authorize the extension of the Fee Deferral Program by resolution.

WHEREAS City Council desires to continue to offer the Fee Deferral Program as an option to facilitate development investment in the City.

RESOLUTION

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

City Council approves the extension of the Fee Deferral Program established pursuant to Ordinance No. 3281 with respect to Application Deadlines set forth in Section 5 as follows:

The City will not accept applications for a fee deferral on or after June 1, 2022 and the City will not approve applications for a fee deferral on or after July 1, 2022.
