#### DISCUSSION

City Council voted at the September 21, 2021 City Council meeting to form a Redistricting Advisory Commission consisting of five directly appointed members and two at-large members. Council Members would each make one direct appointment to the Commission. Those five directly-appointed members would then appoint an additional two at-large members at the first Commission meeting

### Redistricting Advisory Commission Appointments October 5, 2021 - Page 2

Commission Members must be Fullerton residents and at least 18 years old. Commission Members cannot be an elected city official or family member, paid staff member or paid campaign staff of an elected official.
