SUBJECT: 2021 BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT FUNDS

SUMMARY

The Police Department requests City Council accept a \$3,910.54 2021 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant (BVP) allocation from the US Department of Justice for the purchase of bulletproof vests.

RECOMMENDATION

Accept 2021 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant funds and appropriate receipt and use of \$3,910.54 in grant funds.

PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

This item matches the following Priority Policy Statements:

- Fiscal and Organizational Stability
- Public Safety.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BVP \$3,910.54 allocation will enable the Police Department to purchase bulletproof vests with a reduced impact to the General Fund budget. The Police Department budget includes the 50% match required of the BVP grant.

DISCUSSION

The US Department of Justice has awarded the Fullerton Police Department \$3,910.54 through the 2021 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant to purchase required bulletproof vests. The department's policy mandates replacement of assigned bulletproof vests

five years from their issue date. The US Department of Justice approved funding on October 18, 2021.
