SUBJECT: HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS - AMERICAN

RESCUE PLAN FUNDING

SUMMARY

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships – American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (HOME ARP) has allocated funding to the City. Staff requests City Council accept the allocation.

RECOMMENDATION

Accept the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships – American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 allocation and appropriate receipt of funds.

PRIORITY POLICY STATEMENT

This item matches the following Priority Policy Statement:

Fiscal and Organizational Stability.

FISCAL IMPACT

Acceptance \$1,954,345 HOME ARP funds does not impact the general fund. Staff will request appropriation to use allocated HOME ARP at a future meeting after public participation and consultation with interested parties.

DISCUSSION

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 received \$5 billion to provide housing, services, and shelter to individuals experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable populations.

Jurisdictions that qualified for HOME Investment Partnership Program allocations in Fiscal Year 2021, including Fullerton, will receive an appropriation allocated by formula.

Staff will need to conduct public participation and consult with the County's Continuum of Care Board, local non-profits, veterans' groups and public housing agencies as part of the use of the funding, Staff is reviewing the program guidelines and potential projects and will present options for the use of funding at a future City Council meeting.
