A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA, REPEALING NO PARKING ANYTIME ON THE NORTH SIDE OF ROLLING HILLS DRIVE EAST OF STATE COLLEGE BOULEVARD AND DESIGNATING THE SOUTH SIDE OF SAME SEGMENT OF STREET AS A PLACE WHERE VEHICLES ARE PROHIBITED FROM STOPPING AT ANY TIME

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULLERTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. City Council repeals Resolution No. 7742, dated November 17, 1987, in its entirety.
- City Council designates the south side of Rolling Hills Drive, between State College Boulevard and 325 feet east of the centerline of State College Boulevard, in the City of Fullerton, as a place where vehicles are prohibited from stopping at any time.
- 3. City Council directs the Public Works Director to install signing as required by law giving notice of the restriction.
- 4. No person shall stop any vehicle at said location when said signs are in place.
