## 2. REVIEW OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP)

Parks and Recreation Director Curiel gave a brief description of the proposed CIP projects for his department. Director Curiel and Parks and Recreation Commission Chair Gretchen Cox answered questions from the Committee Members and left the meeting at 8:15 a.m.

Senior Civil Engineer Grantham presented the Traffic Signals and Safety Lighting projects and the Storm Drain Improvements projects.

Member Sebourn asked Staff to find out if Brea Boulevard has synchronization north of Bastanchury. Member Lloyd asked Staff to report back on the status of the closed circuit television cameras at the intersection of N. Berkeley Avenue and E. Chapman Avenue. Chair Sandford asked for additional information on the Orangethorpe Avenue Traffic Signal Synchronization Program, and Staff advised they will bring this item back at a subsequent meeting.

The Parks and Recreation projects (1-6), Public Works-Engineering Traffic Signals and Safety Lighting projects (1-6 and 8-10), and Public Works-Engineering Storm Drain Improvement projects (1-3) were tentatively agreed upon by the Committee's general consensus, but no action was taken (see attached matrix).
