# **REGULAR BUSINESS**

2. REVIEW OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP)

Vice Chair Alcantara and Public Works Director McWade arrived at 7:33 a.m. Member Tutor arrived at 7:35 a.m., and Yelena Voronel arrived at 7:38 a.m.

Senior Civil Engineer Grantham reviewed proposed CIP projects for the Library, Community Development, and Public Works-Maintenance and answered questions from Committee Members. It was requested that staff bring back Public Works-Maintenance Project 1 (Annual Anticipated Maintenance Costs) at the next meeting, with a summary of costs over the last five years.

The Library, Community Development, and Public Works-Maintenance (2-5) projects were tentatively agreed upon by the Committee's general consensus, but no action was taken (see attached matrix).

#### STAFF/COMMITTEE COMMUNICATION

Vice Chair Sandford requested a comprehensive discussion on the prioritization schedule for street repairs.

Member Dino asked that the Parks and Recreation Director provide a priority list at the next meeting, and he suggested that Master Plans and priority lists for Water, Sewer, Parks and Recreation, and the Library be posted on the website.

Member Sebourn encouraged Staff and Committee Members to participate in Association of California Cities – Orange County committee meetings.

Member McNelly suggested the City work with MG Disposal to arrange more compost giveaways, and he requested Staff provide an update on the composting workshops at the Arboretum and any fees payed by residents.

Public Works Director McWade noted that the Fullerton Police Department is planning to do an audit of the parks, including recommendations for additional lighting where necessary.
