APPEAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL OF CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR HUMAN SERVICE AGENCY INCLUDING RECUPERATIVE CARE, NAVIGATION CENTER WITH WRAP-AROUND SERVICES AT 3535 WEST COMMONWEALTH AVENUE
